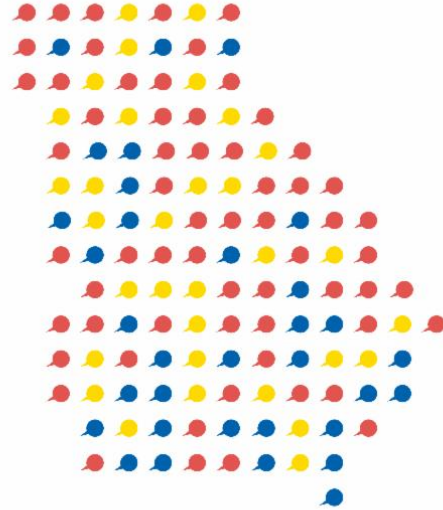

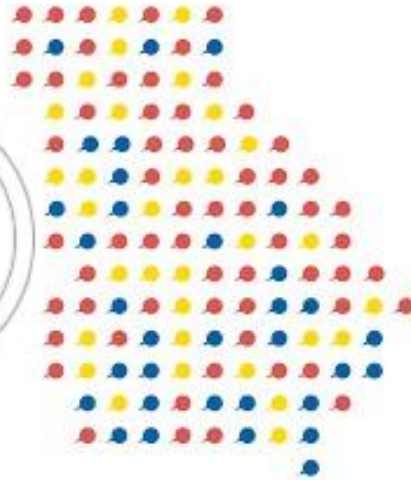


## Valdosta Selected as Finalist for World Smart Cities Award

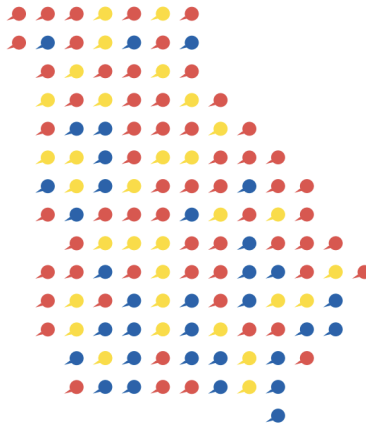
