Project Description:

The Savannah Logistics and Technology Innovation Corridor (“Corridor”) was created via General Assembly General Resolution Act No. 308 (2019).

As a result of this and other resolutions, Georgia Southern University (“GSU”) and the Savannah Economic Development Authority (“SEDA”) created a partnership with a goal of creating an ecosystem, via research and entrepreneurship, that enhances supply chain efficiencies and predictability while also providing further economic opportunities.

The partnership has led to the creation of the Savannah Logistics Innovation Center. This Center is establishing a logistics accelerator and incubator (once the accelerator is up and running) that will enable local, regional, national, international logistics companies and organizations to maximize and partner with startup technology companies focused on the logistics industry.
